


Lumina

A shimmering rhythm of smooth, graphic loops and subtle colour nuances. *Lumina* is an innovative tufted rug featuring tightly packed shiny wool loops, which flow across its surface. Designed by celebrated designers Felix Diener and Ulf Moritz, it has a highly original graphic and 'designed' look.

The distinctive shine and colour richness that characterises *Lumina* comes from the two types of yarn used in its construction. One of these is a special New Zealand wool yarn, which is felted directly in the spinning process. Consequently, unlike most woollen yarns, it can be used to create loops, which are particularly smooth, clean, round and shiny. The other yarn is a polyester braid, which is also very smooth. This adds an elegant sheen and second colour dimension to the rug's surface.

As you look at shiny loops that play across the surface of *Lumina*, different matt and gloss tones emerge from the different yarns, as the light or your perspective changes. This effect gives the rug a particularly individual and vibrant look.

Lumina is available in 14 sophisticated colours, which have been carefully crafted to complement the qualities of the different yarns. These include natural tones such as delicate grey, pale ice blue and light cream, as well as highlight tones, such as bold red and burgundy.

Felix Diener

Originally from southern Germany, textile designer Felix Diener creates rugs, curtains and accessories for the home. His acclaimed work, which forms an interface between art and technology, particularly stands out for its use of colour, materials and textures. As Felix Diener's portfolio reveals, his individual design philosophy extends far beyond colouring and shaping: his creative process is greatly influenced by the search for innovative structures, surfaces, compositions and production techniques.

Ulf Moritz

Polish-born Ulf Moritz has made a significant impact on the world of design, since he began working over 40 years ago. His internationally acclaimed portfolio includes fabrics, carpets, and wallpapers, as well as interior and architectural projects. Ulf Moritz's designs are characterised by colour, texture, light and motion. Frequently featuring highly refined and innovative combinations of fibres and threads, they often highlight previously hidden qualities of a material.
